Welcome to Puyallup Open-Door Program (POD) where we use a combination of hybrid, project based and online class. This model provides students with the ability to receive face-to-face instruction from a teacher, hands on learning, foster relationships with their peers, as well as gain the flexibility of working remotely. We recognize our students come from a wide-range of life circumstances and we strive to maintain wrap-around services which include mental health, drug and alcohol counseling, and community outreach. Our goal is to allow for students to engage in learning in a unique way that will help them be successful in obtaining a high-school diploma, GED, or job training. **To qualify for our Open-Door Program:**

- Must be between the ages of 16-21 years of age
- Be credit deficient and qualify under our credit calculator

High School Diploma/Job-Training Track:

In order to be a part of our program you must commit to the following:

- Attend scheduled classes (in the event of an absence, communicate with your teacher and/or attendance secretary)
- Attend scheduled weekly Life Success class (a mandatory elective course that fulfills attendance requirement)
- Have a transportation plan (*please note we do not provide transportation*)
- You will be given a minimum of three in person classes (hybrid and/or project-based) courses including your Life Success course and three online courses. Please note that if a hybrid/project base courses are full, you will be waitlisted and given an online course. Online courses are self-study and there is limited staff interaction.

GED Track:

- Attend scheduled weekly Life Success class (a mandatory elective course that fulfills attendance requirement)
- Have a transportation plan (*please note we do not provide transportation*)
- *Complete practice GED test*
- *Take GED test in all four areas of math, science, social studies and language arts.*
