Welcome to Puyallup Online Academy (POA) where we use a 50/50 model of online and face to face classes. The hybrid model provides students with the ability to receive face-to-face instruction from a teacher, foster relationships with their peers, as well as gain the flexibility of working remotely.

To qualify for our POA Hybrid Track schedule, you must commit to the following:

- Attend scheduled classes (in the event of an absence, communicate with your teacher and/or attendance secretary)
- Attend scheduled weekly Jumpstart class
- Have a transportation plan (*please note we do not provide transportation*)
- You will be given a minimum of three hybrid courses including your Jump Start course. Please note that if hybrid courses are full you will be waitlisted and given an online course. Online courses are self-study and there is limited staff interaction.

Courses are:

- Self-paced and students can access courses anytime during the day.
- Pre-recorded video based
- Multiple-choice, True/False and some writing or projects
- Managed by a PDL or Edgenuity staff member and no direct instruction take place
